

# **New Procedures**

We have a new procedure to ensure our members get a chance to camp on some of our claims in Northern California. Steve Dowling and Toni Spencer have agreed to be our Northern Claim Liaisons. They will be our go-between with the Forest Service. You can now request a parking permit online at <a href="https://www.valleyprospectors.org/members-only/northern-claims-permits/">https://www.valleyprospectors.org/members-only/northern-claims-permits/</a> This is a password protected site. If you do not recall the password, send a request to valleyprospectors49@gmail.com and it will be sent to all members in good-standing. Or you can call the President, Lorraine Frost, her number is in the newsletter.

When submitting your request, you must provide some essential information so a permit can be issued.

- Valley Prospector Membership Number, Name, Email & Contact Phone
- Which Claim(s) you will be visiting (camping at)
- Number of Day, per claim. (There is a 14-day limit)
- Number of People
- Number and type of vehicles including License number and State issued from
  - Example: Winnebago RV, 1ABC123, CA

This information will be forwarded to the Forestry Service for parking permit issuance. Check out more details on the website. Please note that there is a limited number of parking spaces on each claim and there is a 14-day limit on the claims. Stephen will try to accommodate your requests – which should be sent 2 weeks in advance of your stay.
